National Animal Shelter Appreciation Week - Nov. 1-7

The first full week in November is National Animal Shelter Appreciation Week.

A little history lesson about shelters:

1824 The Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals was formed in Britain and started changing the perception about dogs.

1866 The US version of the SPCA was formed.

1869 The first modern shelter in the US was created by the Women's SPCA of Pennsylvania.

1877 The American Humane Association is formed.

1954 The Humane Society of the US if formed.

1960's and 70's Private animal shelters were formed in addition to the municipal ones in an effort to bring in strays and find them homes. Public opinion about stray animals start to shift and people begin to view them as potential pets rather than public health hazards.

1966 Animal Protectors of Allegheny Valley (AP) is formed as a rescue group. Later, it becomes a full-service shelter.

Mid 1980's AP builds its first shelter after having taken over the operation of the City of New Kensington's dog 'pound'. By the way, the term pound comes from agricultural impoundment lots where animals were impounded until their owners picked them up.

2021 AP moves into its new, state-of-the-art shelter at 730 Church Street.

Now I must go by some other round– Which I shall never find– Somewhere that does not care the sound Of Four-Feet trotting behind.


